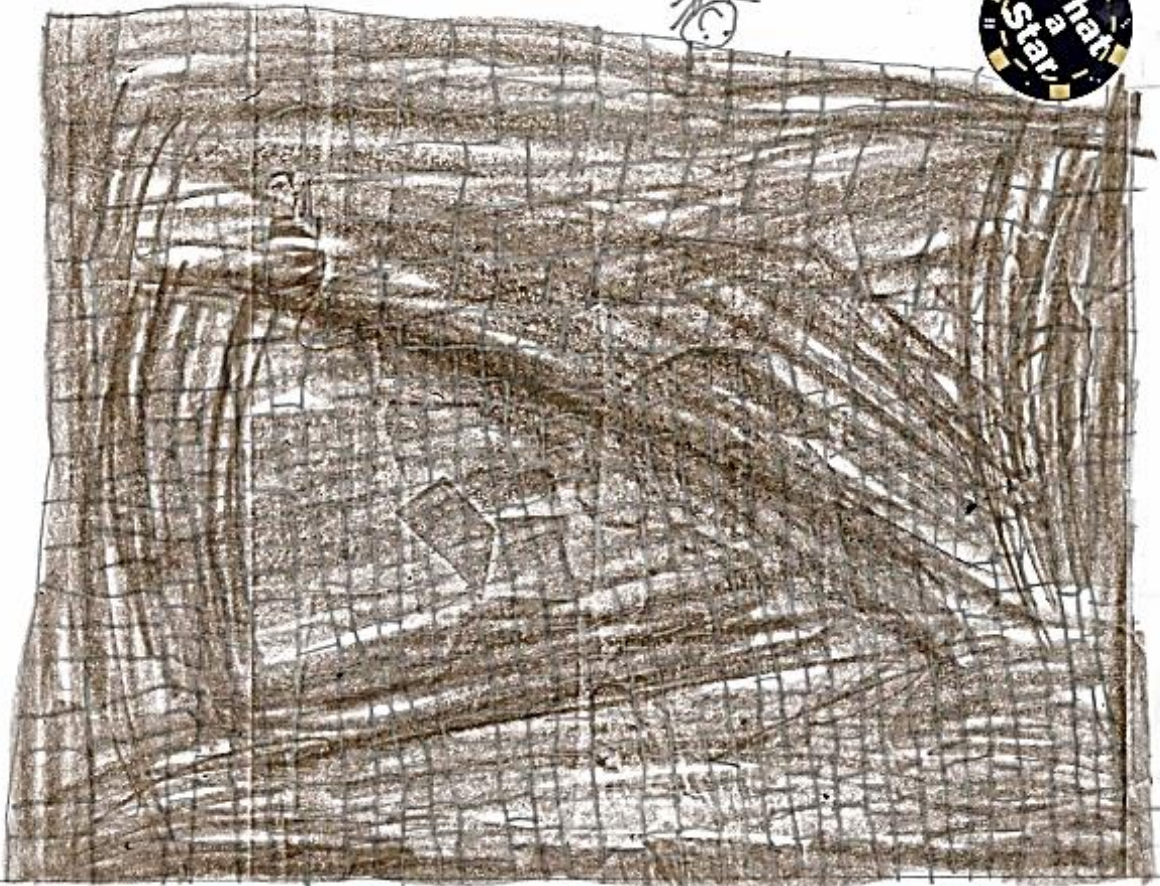

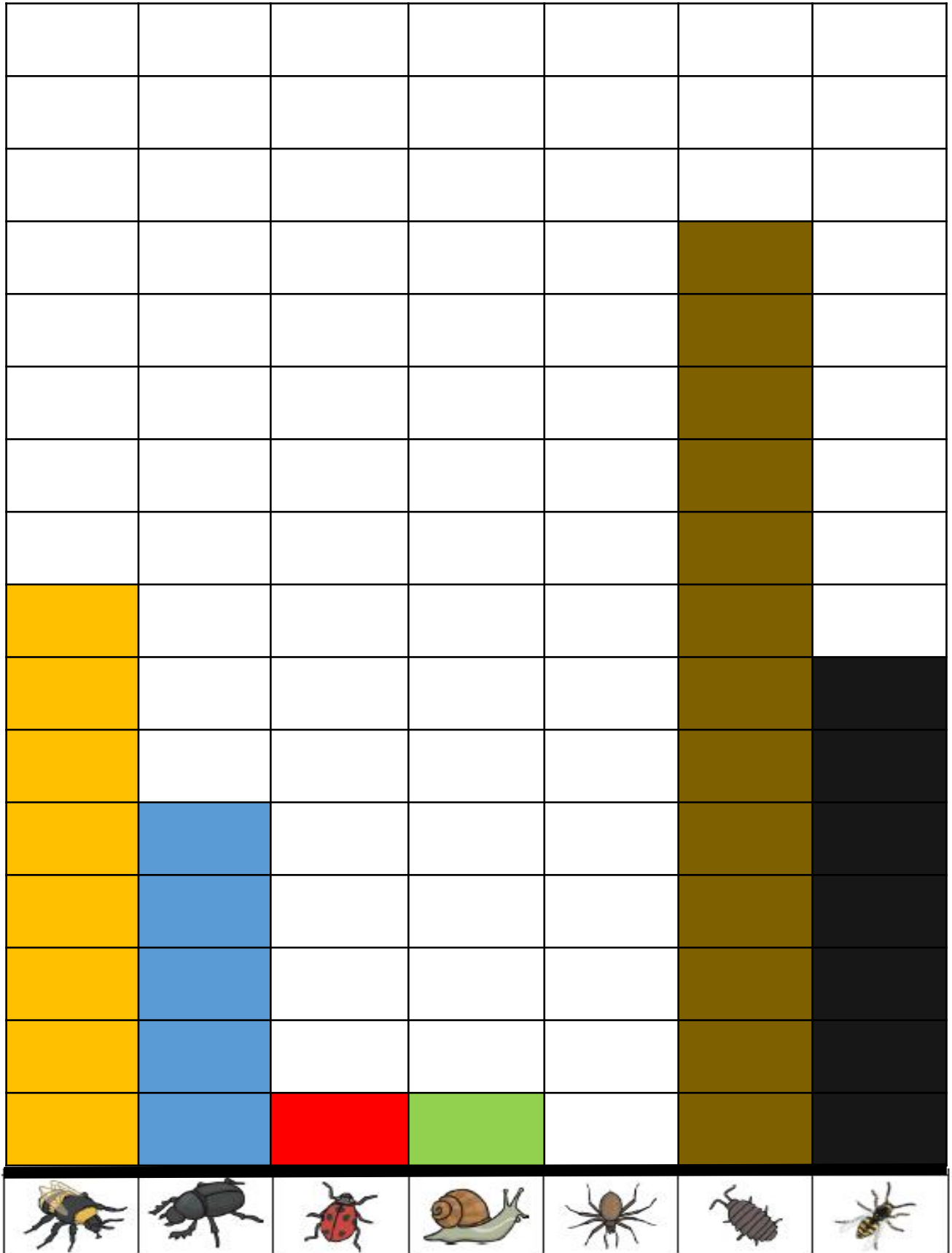

What mini beasts are living in the micro habitats around our school?



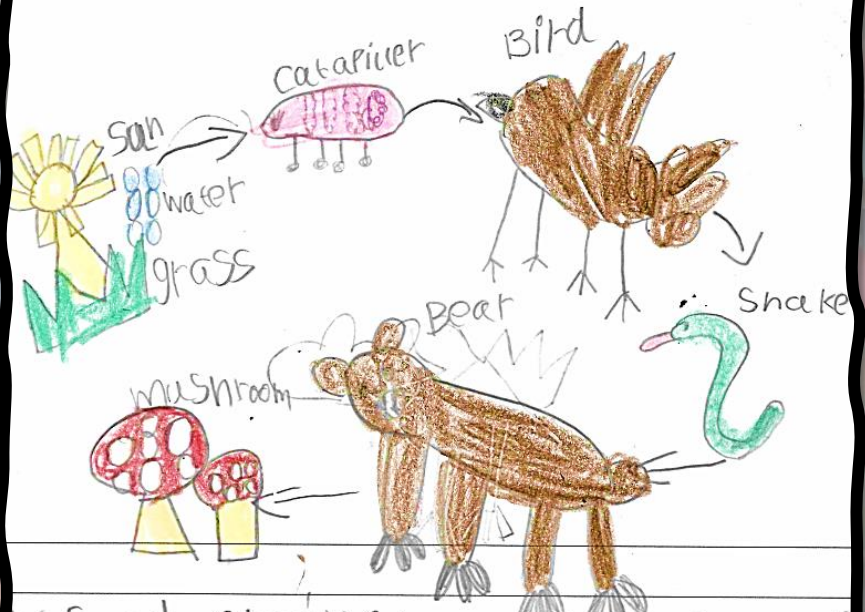
Micro Habitat	Description of the micro habitat	What mini beasts live there
Pond area	Wet, mossy, green, dark, lots of plants, grassy,	Frogs, water flies, tadpoles, frog spawn, water snails,
Bug hotel	Muddy, sheltered, safe, dark	Spider, lady bugs, worms, wood lice
Log circle	Muddy, damp, squishy, soft, dark, safe	Snails, frogs, wood lice, worms, slugs, beetles, spiders
Field	Wide open space, grassy, muddy, damp, soft, wet	Butterfly, flies, bee, wasp, grass hopper, worm, ant
Woodland	Muddy, sheltered, shady, leafy, cold	Birds, dragon fly, beetle, slugs, worms, spiders, ants, snails
